



To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 88,714, for 160 acres, in favor of Following, minor child of Irish Lying Down, (deceased), Warrior, Captain Shoe Boots Company, Cherokee Volunteers, War 1812.

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North half of the North East-quarter of Section Twenty-nine, and the ~~North~~<sup>west</sup> half of the North West-quarter of Section Twenty-eight, in Township One hundred and twenty-four, North of Range Twenty-nine, West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at St. Cloud, Minnesota, containing One Hundred and Sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant having been assigned by Lydia, Guardian of the said Following, to Mathias Zimmer, in whose favor the said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Mathias Zimmer, as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs,

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Mathias Zimmer as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Abraham Lincoln PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
