Motion of American Transmission Company LLC and ATC Management Inc. to Intervene As a Full Party and Notice of Appearance

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §227.44(2m) and Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 2.21, American Transmission Company LLC and its corporate manager, ATC Management Inc. (collectively referred to as "ATC"), by their attorney, Charles J. Cummings, hereby move to intervene in the captioned docketed matter and request full party status.

I. STATEMENT OF INTEREST

1. On June 20, 2011, the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSCW), issued a notice of proceeding in this docket which included a fourteen (14) day deadline for any interested person who wishes to become a party to the proceeding to request party status. The proceeding in question involves an application by Dairyland Power Cooperative, Northern States Power-Wisconsin and Wisconsin Public Power, Inc. (applicants), for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct new electric transmission facilities including a proposed 345 kV transmission line crossing the Mississippi River at or near Alma, Wisconsin that would

continue 40-55 miles (depending on the route selected) to a new substation near Holmen,

Wisconsin.

2. ATC is a transmission company within the meaning of §196.485(1)(ge) and is the

owner and operator of the transmission facilities throughout most of Wisconsin.

3. ATC has begun planning studies, preliminary feasibility analyses and public outreach

efforts concerning a proposed 150 mile (approximate) 345 kV transmission line and associated

facilities from the Madison, Wisconsin area to the La Crosse, Wisconsin area, also known as the

Badger Coulee project. It is anticipated that the Badger Coulee project would interconnect with

the applicant's project, the subject of this proceeding. As a result, ATC has a substantial interest

in this proceeding that may be directly affected by the PSCW's action and this interest will not

be represented by any other parties to the proceeding.

Charles Cummings will be the attorney for ATC in this proceeding. ATC requests that
