- 1. Before noon on Friday, May 18, 2012, the Applicants shall file a delayed exhibit to be identified as Ex.-Applicants-Stevenson-22 that includes all of the following:
 - a. Cost information for a route segment modification that crosses from the Q1-Galesville route north of Holmen to the Q1-Highway 35 route at a point north of the United States Highway 53-State Highway 35 interchange. From Segment 18A north of the node with Segment 18B on the Q1-Galesville route, the new segment would run west along property lines, cross United States Highway 53, and then run south to connect with Segment 8C on the Q1-Highway 35 route.
 - b. The total cost for the Q1-Galesville route as modified by the Commission's discussion of record, broken down by cost categories as shown in Table 4.5-2 on page 48 of the Final Environmental Impact Statement.

An updated list of municipalities eligible for the annual high-voltage c. transmission impact fee and the one-time environmental impact fee, and the percentage

of the route that passes through each of these municipalities to reflect the route as

modified by the Commission's discussion of record.

d. Information on costs related to lower voltage transmission and distribution

work that would be excluded from the annual high-voltage transmission impact fee and

the one-time environmental impact fee calculations to be consistent with the

Commission's discussion of record.

2. Before noon on Thursday, May 24, 2012, a party may file comments on the

Applicant's delayed exhibit.
