ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION TO CITIZENS ENERGY TASK FORCE and MIDWEST ISO, STAYING DEADLINE TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY AND SCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 31, 2008, a Petition to Intervene was filed with the Administrative Law Judge by the Citizens Energy Task Force seeking full party status in this proceeding. However, there was no evidence that the matter had been served on the parties to the proceeding. On April 10, 2008, the Administrative Law Judge contacted Beverly Topp, the Citizens Energy Task Force representative, to notify her that she must give notice of her request to the other parties. On the same day, the Citizens Energy Task Force refiled its Petition to Intervene. On April 18, 2008, Paula Goodman Maccabee filed a Notice of Appearance on behalf of the Citizens Energy Task Force. On April 11, 2008, the Midwest Independent System Operator (Midwest ISO) filed a Petition to Intervene seeking full party status in this proceeding.

As set forth in the Prehearing Order issued on January 3, 2008, and Minn. R. 1400.6200, subd. 2, any party objecting to the intervention must file its objection within seven days of receipt of the petition. No party filed an objection to either petition to intervene.

The proposed intervenors have demonstrated that they have a basis for intervention in this proceeding and that the outcome will directly affect their interests.

On April 16, 2008, the North American Water Office (NAWO) and the Institute for Local Self-Reliance (ILSR) filed a Petition For An Extension of Time to Prepare Direct Testimony. On April 18, 2008, NO CAP X and Wind on the Wires, Izaak Walton League of America – Midwest Office, Fresh Energy and the Minnesota Center for Environmental Advocacy filed memoranda in support of NAWO and ILSR's Petition. On April 21, 2008, the Applicants filed a memorandum in opposition to the Petition.

The Application in this matter was deemed complete by the Public Utilities Commission on November 27, 2007. A Prehearing Conference was held on December 19, 2007, and the preliminary schedule was set. This proceeding involves three separate, large transmission projects and it was anticipated that the schedule could change as the matter progressed. A discovery process was set, and parties were directed to respond to Information Requests within fifteen business days of receipt or to notify the requesting party if the response could not be provided within that timeframe. Since the Prehearing Conference, additional parties have petitioned to intervene in the proceeding and some Information Responses have not been provided within fifteen days. There is no date upon which the discovery schedule closes. Discovery may continue after the testimony is filed, up to the completion of the evidentiary hearing.

According to the schedule in the Prehearing Conference, the Direct Testimony was to be filed within four months from the date of the Prehearing Order. In light of the cope of the proposed project, this was an aggressive schedule.

The Environmental Report was issued by the Department of Commerce, Office of Energy Security on March 31, 2008. Since it was issued, the Public Utilities Commission has been asked to consider the scope of the Environmental Report and is accepting comments on that request.

Based on the record herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
